





Seeking recognition through the 100% Efficiency Plan is more than just a formal procedure for acknowledgment; it's a strategic move to synchronize the National Organization with international JCI trends, aiming for national and local-level growth and development.

RECOGNITION CATEGORIES

Super-Efficient National Organization-Achieving a score higher than 120%
100% Efficient National Organization-attaining atleast 100%, but below 119%
Efficient National Organization-ranging from 85% to 99%
National Organization with Good Management-scoring between 75% to 84%

TIMELINE

Jan-Oct : Accomplishment of tasks in accordance with the specified regulations and time table of the 100% Efficiency Plan Initiative

Oct : National Organizations can seek recognition for the 100% Efficiency Plan by utilizing the provided online application form.

Nov : The official recognition will be presented to the National Organizations during the World Congress

100% Efficiency Plan Guidelines

A revised version of the previous program. The updated guidelines align with the 2024 Plan of Actions Initiatives, offering National Organizations the flexibility to select criteria based on their specific national objectives.Notable changes include a reduction in mandatory points, ensuring a more attainable path to recognition.

Introduction

The "Shadow the President" Program is a unique initiative to offer Junior Chamber International (JCI) members an unparalleled opportunity to accompany the JCI President during visits, events, and engagements. This program aims to provide participants with an immersive experience that grants firsthand insights into the role and responsibilities of the JCI President while enhancing their understanding of JCI's global operations and impact. By facilitating this opportunity, JCI seeks to foster mentorship, inspire aspiring leaders, and contribute to the personal and professional development of its members.

Program Objectives

- To provide JCI members with a unique opportunity to shadow the JCI President and gain insights into their daily activities, engagements, and leadership strategies.
- To deepen participants' understanding of JCI's global operations, projects, and initiatives.
- To create a platform for networking and building relationships with international leaders and stakeholders.
- To inspire and mentor aspiring leaders within the JCI community. We aim to give this opportunity to grassroots members not necessarily only to upcoming leaders, anyone who has the enthusiasm can apply for this program.
- To contribute to the personal and professional development of program participants.





1. Application Process:

- JCI members interested in participating in the program will need to submit a formal application to the national organization. More than one shadower per visit could be assigned, usually 2 or 3.
- Applications will be reviewed and selected by the national organization based on criteria such as commitment to JCI's values, leadership potential, professional background, and motivation for participating.

2. Selection and Notification:

- Selected participants will be notified via email or official communication channels.
- A waiting list may be maintained in case of any dropouts.
- The President will be sent by the national organization the names and CVs (both JCI and professional) of the members who will shadow him. This will be provided by mail, copy to the JCI Secretary General, GD Director for the Area, and the Assistant team.

3. Program Duration:

Participants should be prepared for engagements that may span a few days to a week.

4. Financial Obligations:

- Participants will be responsible for covering their own travel, accommodation, and meal expenses during the program.
- It is recommended that participants explore sponsorship options through their local or national organizations, partnerships, or personal funding.

5. Benefits for Participants:

- Exclusive opportunity to observe and interact with the JCI President during visits, events, and engagements, and also learn how JCI works in different countries.
- In-depth understanding of the role and responsibilities of the JCI President and their impact on the global community.
- Networking opportunities with international leaders, stakeholders, and fellow participants.
- Exposure to diverse projects and initiatives within the JCI network.
- Enhanced leadership and professional development through first hand experiences.

6. Expectations of Participants:

- Demonstrate a high level of professionalism, respect, and active engagement during the program.
- Act as ambassadors of JCI, promoting its values and objectives.
- Be open to learning and absorbing insights from the President and other leaders.
- Share their experiences and learning outcomes with their local chapters and the broader JCI community.

7. Program Evaluation:

- Participants may be asked to provide feedback about their experiences upon completion of the program.
- This feedback will be used to enhance the program for future iterations.

8. Program Reach and Goals:

- The goal is to implement this program in 10 different countries or to reach at least 75 participants shadowing the President during his term.
- JCI will actively promote the program through its communication channels to encourage widespread participation.
